1. In an 8U softball game with no one on base, the batter hits the ball to the pitcher's 1 pts. helper. The throw to 1B gets past the first baseman, past the foul line, but stays in play. The runner then proceeds past first base, toward second base, when the 1st baseman retrieves the over thrown ball and attempts to throw the ball to 2nd base. The throw is missed and goes into left field. The runner continues to run to 3B before the defense gets the ball to the pitcher's helper in the circle. The umpire is correct in making the batter-runner go back to 2nd base.




